## Happy New Year from Blue House Uganda!

Uganda reopened schools at the start of 2022, marking the end of the world's longest school closure, the COVID-19 pandemic. Reopening of schools was very much welcomed by Blue House students who enjoyed their 2022 academic year. All the children have been vaccinated and boosted, and none of them caught Covid!

The school year ended on 15th December with an end-of-year party; the girls wore beautiful Christmas dresses and enjoyed a special meal and cake. All this was made possible through your generous funding. The students entertained the board and staff with songs and dance. The next day, they left the Blue House and returned to relatives' homes for the holidays. They will report back on 29th, January 2023. Each child was gifted with an appropriate hygiene package (bath soap, body lotion and feminine hygiene products as needed). Students, staff, parents and guardians were extremely appreciative of the much-needed financial support they received during 2022.

The school year ended with a total of 36 beneficiaries under Blue House support:

Tertiary Institution Scholars	4 Girls
University Scholar	1 Girl

Tertiary education (community college equivalent) takes 2-3 years depending on the institution and course of choice. University education takes 3-4 years for most courses and 5 years for medical school.

Of the four girls attending tertiary institutions, one is studying micro finance, one is studying tourism and two are studying agriculture. The university scholar, Lillian, is in

her second year of medical school at Busitema University. Director Merab Gloria is very appreciative of all your support towards the children's education and basic needs.

The following provides the breakdown of the resident and home-based students:

Primary 1 – 4 (1st – 4th grade)	9
Primary 5 – 7 (5th – 7th grade)	14
Senior 1 – 4 (8th – 11th grade)	7
Senior 5 (12th grade)	1

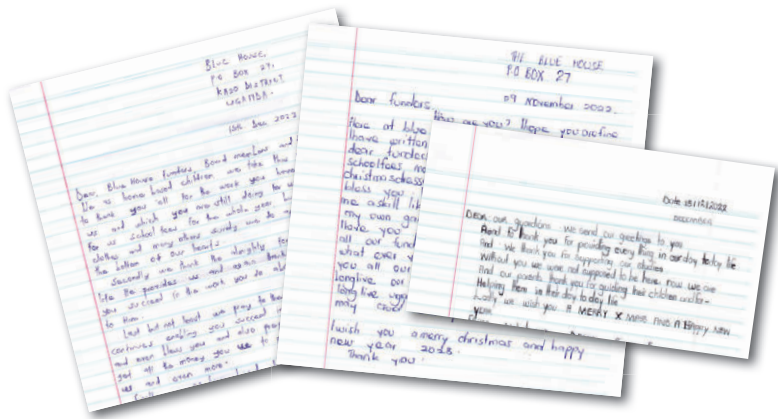
Primary seven (seventh grade), senior four (eleventh grade) and senior six (thirteenth grade) are pivotal classes for Ugandan students; they must sit national exams at the end of these school years. Passing or failing of these grades/classes greatly determines a student's future academic trajectory and career path. Three students completed primary seven and three students completed senior four. Results of their exams will be out in 2023.

Director Merab Gloria together with Hope Multipurpose Education Board in Uganda are doing everything they can to ensure that the students receive the best education within their reach and means. 🏠

## Land Purchase

The US Blue House Board is in the process of purchasing a 0.37-acre parcel of land adjacent to the Blue House, Kazo. An unfinished building exists on site which the Blue House Uganda Board would like to complete and turn into a day care facility to generate additional income for day-to-day activities of the Blue House. Additionally, there are plans to construct living quarters for Blue House staff on that land.

## Assessment Report for new beneficiaries

The Kazo community applicant homes were assessed by Blue House's social worker in October. Following the assessment, the Blue House Uganda board sat and recommended nine potential beneficiaries (seven girls and two boys) to be supported by the Blue House. These children range from seven to eleven years of age and most live in a single parent or guardian household. The majority have an educational level of kindergarten to primary one (first grade). The Blue House makes it possible to go to school.

The photos show a few of the potential beneficiaries recommended by the Blue House Uganda board to join in 2023 as the new term begins. Donations towards the Blue House will provide these children opportunity for health, safety and education, and an opportunity to change a family, a community, and the world.



Akanyijuka (left) is 8 years old and in primary one. He lives with his siblings and mother who lost her husband and has difficulty raising school fees and necessities for her 7 children.



Nyongyera (left) 8 years of age is in kindergarten. Her father is deceased; she lives with her mother. They don't have land for agriculture and sometimes survive on the mercy of their neighbors.



Atuhairu 7 years of age is in kindergarten. She lives with her 63-year-old grandmother who also takes care of several other grandchildren.



Aijuka (right), 9 years of age with his cousin and his 78-year-old grandmother.
